This addendum is incorporating the following clarifications into the above-referenced Invitation for Bid-Best Value (IFB-BV).

1.0 CLARIFICATIONS

- 1.1 For fluid levels or exact gallon requirements for each machine the Vendor shall follow the ZEP Dyna Clean Installation and Operator's Manual.

The manual for the model 915201 states the operation is as follows:

IV. Operation

1. Open cover of parts cleaner.
2. Place parts to be cleaned in the center of the parts washer.
3. Adjust solvent flow over parts to be cleaned.
4. Turn on the switch located on the right side of the machine to start the flow of solvent.
5. Open the valve to allow fluid to flow through the brush.
6. To soak parts, place the magnetic stopper over the drain hole and **fill the sink to a level not to exceed 6" in depth.**
7. Turn off unit when operation is complete. Do not allow unit to operate unattended.
8. Allow excess solvent to drip from parts.
9. Remove the part from the parts washer.
10. Close cover to reduce solvent loss due to evaporation.

The manual for the model 964101 states the general information is as follows:

A. General Information

Read and understand all labels, MSDS, and this instruction manual before use.

In some parts of the United States, local or state agencies have adopted an existing EPA requirement for vapor degreasing equipment and applied them to solvent parts washers. **Part of the requirement is that the distance from the top of the machine to the surface of the cold cleaning solvent be at least \square of the smaller of the two dimensions of the opening; commonly referred to as a .75 FREEBOARD RATIO. Your Dyna-Brute FB or Super Brute FB has been designed to meet or exceed this standard when filled to the proper level as indicated on the side of the pump module.**

- 1.2 All quantities listed on the bid sheet are estimates only. The Vendor shall bid the items based on the quantities provided on the bid sheet. Additionally, Vendors will not make "full changes" of solvent every month to all of these units. The monthly inspections of these units are for, "inspecting the machines for needed repairs, replacing filters, replenishing solvents, and cleaning the parts-washers". The solvent is not to be replaced at each inspection time.

2.0 ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS REMAIN THE SAME.
