1.0 Questions:

- 1.1 (Q) We noticed in Section 0500 Scope of Work that when the vendor is to submit final editions of translated documents, that a secure server is required. Is there anyway you could please specify if there is any technological or software requirement necessary, for our servers to be secure for this process?
- (A) The City will require a server that communicates using some form of a secure protocol (SSL, TLS, SSH, etc.) and depending on the solution's architecture, the system will also need to be hardened for Internet exposure (see here for definitions: <http://www.serverhardening.com/>; <https://technet.microsoft.com/en-us/security/jj720323.aspx>). Unfortunately, there are so many ways to accomplish both of these requirements, the City doesn't want to define specific solution architectures and will rely on your proposal referenced in the required documentation in your response to assess department suitability.
