SUBJECT: Answers to Questions

The following are answers to Bidders questions on the above project. These answers do not modify the Contract. Any modifications to the Contract will be through Addenda.

Q-1: Where are the Standard Products Lists (SPL) for the manhole coating products?

A-1: All of the SPLs are found online at <http://austintexas.gov/page/current-standard-products-lists>. The manhole coating products are WW-511, WW-511A, and WW-511B.

Q-2: What permits are required?

A-2: For work within the City's Right-of-Way, a Right-of-Way Permit from the Austin Transportation Department will be required. If digging, then an Excavation Permit is required. If there is no excavation, then a Temporary Right of Way Use Permit is required.

Contractor is responsible for paying for all permits except those identified in 00810 Paragraph 6.6. If special permits for a specific assignment are required they will be identified and discussed at the time of the assignment.
