1.0 The following clarifications are provided in response to questions from potential respondents:

1. The RFP states that the location must be within the city limits. What if the location we propose is within 1000 ft of the city line in the ETJ zone? Would that work? *A proposed recycling/reuse drop-off center may be located either inside the Austin City Limits or within the ETJ. There is a possibility that the City will award multiple contracts for this RFP. In order to provide easy access to the greatest number of citizens, ARR will aim to achieve through the award of contracts an efficient distribution of drop-off locations throughout the overall service area. Location is only one of several evaluation factors. The evaluation factor covering location, facility and equipment for each drop-off center being proposed represents a maximum of 15 out of a possible 100 points to be awarded. Proposed locations outside of the city limits are not subject to city zoning, but must comply with all applicable county and state development regulations.*
2. *In Section 4.B.(3) of the Proposal Preparation Instructions and Evaluation Factors, second bullet, change the word "safety" to "safely."*
3. Please change Section 5.4 of the Scope of Work to read as follows: *"Each Center must be operated and maintained in a manner that is continuously in compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances and development regulations."*

4.0 All other terms and conditions will remain the same
