This addendum incorporates the following changes, questions, and answers to the above-referenced RFP.

1. Q) Section 0500, Scope of Work, Item 4.4.1., indicate the need for an unlimited data plan for vehicles, and that is part of the annual maintenance fee. Most of our customers only secure a data plan that covers the monthly data requirements for the solution (250MB to 2GB plans per vehicle, based on system options), as this is more economical than “unlimited” data plans. Why does the City require “unlimited” plans? Are alternative plans (e.g., 2GB/month) plans acceptable as long as they meet system requirements?
 - A) The City has a contract for an unlimited data plan on units that have mobile data systems installed. This will cover the data required for the proposed application, internet, future video needs, OS, and security updates for the device.

2. Q) Section 0500, Scope of Work, Item 4.12, please confirm the City will setup a testing environment for the vendor to have access to Oracle, etc. during the integration development and testing period, at a minimum.
 - A) Testing environment will be setup

3. Q) Section 0500, Scope of Work, Item 4.12, please provide clarification on the extent of load and environmental testing the City expects?
 - A) A test plan should be provided and conducted for system, integration and load testing to simulate an expected production environment. The testing should address functionality, usability, reliability, performance, and supportability.

4. Q) Would the City consider a VOIP technology as a substitution for this requirement? What specific voice integration are you looking for with back office staff? Does the City have a current VOIP or VoLTE solution in place today? If so, what system is being utilized?
 - A) The City will consider a VOIP solution if it can demonstrate that it will be compatible with LTE systems. The city does not have a VOIP or VoLTE solution in place at this time.

5. Q) Can the City supply the specs for the antennas they would like to reuse with the new systems?
 - A) Low-profile Broadband Antenna: LTE- PCTEL PN: BMLPVMB/LTE (black finish only) Low-profile GPS Antenna: Larsen PN: GPSNMO02 .-02 denotes black finish, -01 denotes white finish.

6. Q) Does the City expect the successful proposer to supply the unlimited data plans? Given that the RFP states the City would like the existing SIMs to be reused if possible can it be assumed this is not necessarily the case? Who is their current service provider?
 - A) The City uses an unlimited data plan on units that have mobile data systems installed.
