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**Solicitation: RFP TVN0058    Addendum No: 3    Date of Addendum: January 6, 2016**

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This addendum is to incorporate the following changes to the above referenced solicitation:

**I.    Questions:**

**Q2: Section 2 of the Scope of Work refers to \$250 million in construction contracts. Is this several projects totaling that amount or a single project for \$250 million?**

**A2:** There is one contract, for a Construction Manager at Risk (CMR), between a single vendor and the City. The full scope of work will involve multiple Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) agreements, and each may be subject to a different wage rate determination or determinations. Within each GMP, the CMR will conduct multiple solicitations, for specific subcontracts and scopes of work, on behalf of the City. The City needs to track payroll submissions for each of these solicitations individually. The aggregate sum for the City's CMR contract will be approximately \$250 million. Total contract duration is approximately 4 years.

**Q3: How will legacy data can be migrated from the current system to our system and what kind of legacy system is the City of Austin is currently using, output file format, what kind of data needs to be pulled into LCPtracker?**

**A3:** We currently use a spreadsheet to track submission of certified payroll reports, and would want to combine that data into an all-inclusive payroll submission record for the entire contract. Payroll submission tracking must be able to export data in a standard format, using standard software, such as Microsoft Excel. (Wage Compliance is moving away from Access for data collection and reporting in the near future.)

**Q4: Will the City will need data to flow back and forth between LCPtracker and COA system?**


**A4:** At this time, no data flow back and forth is necessary; however, data flow from provider to COA and from contractors to provider will be required.
