V. UPHOLSTERY SCHEDULE & SPECIFICATIONS

I. GENERAL CONDITIONS

A. DEFINITIONS

1. **Bid** a complete, properly signed response to an Invitation for Bid, which if accepted, would bind the Bidder to perform the resultant Contract.
2. **Bidder** a person, firm, or entity that submits a Bid in response to an Invitation for Bid. Any Bidder may be represented by an agent after submitting evidence demonstrating the agent's authority. The agent cannot certify as to his own agency status.
3. **Furniture Vendor** a person, firm, or entity that sells Goods and/or Services.
4. **Close-out documents** means the product brochures, product/equipment maintenance and operations instructions, manuals, warranties, affidavit of payment, etc., and as may be further identified and required by the Contract Documents.
5. **Contract** a binding legal agreement between the City and the Offeror. The Contract includes, without limitation, the Solicitation, the Offer submitted in response to the Solicitation, the Contract award, the Standard Purchase Terms and Conditions, Supplemental Terms and Conditions if any, Specifications, and any addenda and amendments thereto. Any inconsistency or conflict in the Contract documents shall be resolved by giving precedence in the following order:
 - A. any exceptions to the Offer accepted in writing by the City
 - B. the Supplemental Purchase Terms and Conditions CITY OF AUSTIN PURCHASING OFFICE STANDARD PURCHASE DEFINITIONS Section 0100, Standard Purchase Definitions 2 Revised 02/29/08
 - C. the Standard Purchase Terms and Conditions
 - D. the Offer, exhibits, and attachments; within the Offer, drawings (figured dimensions shall govern over scaled dimensions) will take precedence over specifications or scope of work.
6. **Contract Documents** means the Purchase Order(s) the General Conditions of the Contract, any Drawings and Specifications, Bid/Proposal Documents including the Advertisement, Invitation and Instruction to Bidder/Proposer, Vendor's Proposal and Bid Bonds, Notice of Contract Award and all Addenda issued prior to the execution of the Contract.
7. **Contract Time** means the period of time, expressed in calendar days, described in the Contract Documents for completion of all required Work. There may be different Contract Times for designated portions of the Work or for different aspects of the Work.
8. **Day** means calendar day, unless otherwise specifically stipulated.

9. Drawings means the work product of the Architecture Design Firm and/or Interior Designer that depicts the location and quantity of elements of the Work.

10. Final Completion means the date established by the Owner in writing when the Contract is fully performed according to the Contract Documents and is accepted by the Owner.

11. Installation Time means the portion of the Contract Time, expressed in calendar days in the **Contract Documents**, or scheduled by the Furniture Vendor and approved by the Owner, for the actual on-site delivery and installation of the items of Work at the Project. The Installation Time will commence as specified in the **Contract Documents** or as mutually agreed by the Furniture Vendor and the Owner.

12. Interior Designer means a person licensed as an interior designer pursuant Texas Occupations Code Ch. 1053 or a firm employed by Owner to provide professional interior design services and exercising overall responsibility for the design of a Project or a significant portion thereof, and performing certain contract administration responsibilities as set forth in the Contract.

13. Owner means City of Austin.

14. Project means the building into which the furniture and furnishings described by the Contract Documents will be installed.

15. Samples means the physical examples of materials, furniture, equipment or workmanship, that are representative of some portion of the Work and which establish standards by which the Work will be judged.

16. Shop Drawings means the drawings, diagrams, illustrations, schedules, performance charts, brochures and other data which are prepared by the Furniture Vendor, manufacturer, supplier or distributor, and which illustrate some portions of the Work.

17. Site means the geographical area of the location where the Work is to be performed.

18. Specifications means the Interior Designer's work product which establishes the quality of the products and processes to be used to produce the Work.

19. Substantial Completion means the date jointly certified by the Furniture Vendor, Owner, and Interior Designer when the Work, or a designated portion of the Work, is so sufficiently complete in accordance with the Contract Documents as to be functionally operational in all its components and fit for the use for which it is intended.

20. Unit Price means a price for one item, for one lot or group of items or components.

21. Work means the furnishing of all plant labor, equipment, appliances, tools, and materials, and performing all necessary or incidental operations in connection with the furnishings and installation of all Furniture and Furnishings in strict accordance with the Contract Documents.

B. CONFORMITY OF PRODUCT SOURCES

Items which are understood to be part of a design set, such as a credenza, book shelf, and desk in an office, therefore should match in design, finish, construction and appearance. All shall be provided from the same source. Any deviation from this in the Bidding Documents shall be not be approved.

C. C.O.M FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

The cost for procurement and handling of any Customer's Own Material (C.O.M.) fabric specified shall be included in the price of the Bid. The Furniture Vendor is responsible for verifying if fabric is appropriate for the specified application. Written notification determining inappropriate application shall be submitted to (*whom?*). If no such notification is issued, the Furniture Vendor shall be responsible for warranty on fabric and product. The Furniture Vendor is further responsible for ordering the fabric and providing it to the manufacturer.

It is also the responsibility of the Bidder to accurately calculate yardage for C.O.M. fabric for pricing. The Bidder must take into account the vertical and horizontal repeats on any given item specified.

The low responsive Bidder of any awarded proposal shall be responsible for obtaining approval of the use of any C.O.M. fabrics on specific manufacturer's lines where those C.O.M. are not already approved. This approval shall be obtained prior to ordering.

Should a fabric in any given manufacturer's standard line be one that is planning to be discontinued between the date of receipt of Purchase Order and the installation date, the Furniture Vendor shall be responsible for procuring the required fabric and furniture, so as not to jeopardize the fabric selection or scheduled installation date.

D. MODULAR FURNITURE REQUIREMENTS

If there are any components missing from the furniture specifications, the Bidder shall notify the Owner at least 10 days prior to the bid submittal. An addendum will be issued addressing the discrepancy. If missing parts are identified award if contract, it shall be the Furniture Vendor's responsibility to provide the missing parts at his/her own expense.

The installer shall obtain the services of a factory-trained supervisor to oversee the installation of the modular furniture in the scope. Installer is to field verify dimensions of the location of the systems furniture prior to ordering and installation and notify

Karla Dodson, RID of any discrepancies. Installer to verify walls are free from obstructions (i.e. thermostats, switches) prior to installation.

Data and communications cabling shall be done by others. Installer is to coordinate the schedule of installation with the Interior Designer.

Installer to locate starting point of installation per location noted or by critical dimension noted. Installer is to contact the Owner if discrepancies surface.

Installer is to coordinate delivery and storage of systems and tools with the Owner prior to installation.

Installer is to verify that all workstations are level and in good working order after installation is complete.

All keys should remain in locking mechanisms and in an unlocked position. All task lights shall be in the off position. All flipper doors and file doors shall be closed. Work surfaces are to be set at 29" high unless otherwise noted. Work surfaces to be installed to maintain continuous level work surface. Gaps are to be a minimal butt joint.

There shall be a black extension cord with a minimum of three grounding-type outlets and a surge protector provided for every chair location within a modular furniture area.

E. KEYING REQUIREMENTS

A master key that will unlock all tumblers and a plug removal key for casegoods, modular furniture components that are keyed and files, shall be given to the Owner's representative, unless an alternate contact is listed in the specification or given by the Interior Designer.

Unless otherwise specified, key cores shall be installed so that rooms are keyed alike among items from the same manufacturer in that room. Unless otherwise directed, rooms shall be random keyed and different from the neighboring space.

F. FINISH SAMPLES

Wherever finish is required to match Owner's sample of laminate or wood, approval of finish sample shall be obtained from the Interior Designer prior to fabrication. The manufacturer shall submit such submittal sufficiently in advance to allow for multiple submittals and not compromise the installation date.

G. CLEANUP REQUIREMENTS

All furniture is to be cleaned and ready to use **PRIOR TO** Final Walk Through by Furniture Vendor and Owner. All loose or dangling threads shall be trimmed,

handprints and dust from surfaces shall be removed, and any carpet or area rugs in the furniture contract shall be vacuumed.

The Furniture Vendor/Installer shall sweep, dust and clean up all trash, rubbish, and other waste resulting in the installation under this Contract. The Owner shall determine the extent of the cleaning up after a final inspection at the completion of the Contract. No empty cartons, crates, wrappings, trash, rubbish are to be left in the building or on the project site overnight. If the area is not cleaned to the Owner's satisfaction, the Owner may make arrangements for cleanup and the cost shall be back-charged to the Contractor. Notification will be provided prior to this action taking place.

H. SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR THIS PROJECT

Furniture Contractor and/or Installer are to review the site conditions and have an understanding of the access to the building and the areas within the building.

The Furniture Vendor will be allowed to back up one truck to the building for unloading. No other parking or unloading space is available adjacent to the site. Furniture Vendors will need to make other arrangements. They will be allowed to use the building's restroom facilities. All packing materials must be removed from the site daily. The Furniture Vendor is responsible for the protection of finished walls and finished floors.

I. TIME OF COMPLETION

The Furniture Vendor shall agree to commence work on or before a date to be specified in a written "Notice to Proceed" from the Owner and shall fully complete the Work by the date specified in the **Bidding and Contract Documents**.

J. EQUAL PRODUCTS AND SUBSTITUTIONS

Specification Standards. The specifications, drawings or schedules, where noted, do not limit the Furniture Vendor to supplying the products of any particular manufacturer, distributor or supplier unless a sole source procurement is specifically required and Basis of Design is indicated. Where any article, item, material is specified by proprietary name, trade name, manufacturer, or catalog number, it has been done so to set a definite standard and/or style and to provide a reference for comparison as to quality, design, appearance, physical conformity and approximate dimensions including equivalent value. Alternate products may be submitted to the Owner for consideration as "equal" to the specified product if they meet or exceed all characteristics of the specified product.

Owners Right of Approval. The Owner has the right to determine whether a proposed substitute item is, in the Owner's sole and exclusive judgment, equal or better in all respects to the specified item or items. The decision of the Owner on all such questions of inequality shall be final. Rejection of a substitute item by the Owner shall not give rise to any claim of any nature against the Owner.

Obligation of the Furniture Vendor to Furnish the Items Specified and/or Approved Substitute Items. The Furniture Vendor is required to base its proposal on items specified and approved. If the Furniture Vendor, at the time of preparation of his bid, offered a substitute for the specified item or items, the specified item or items shall be required unless all of the following conditions have been met:

The Owner will complete evaluation once he or she has physically received complete pertinent data and specifications including a complete and final sample no later than the date specified in the **Instruction to Bidders**.

Approval by the Owner, of the "equivalent item or product" shall be done in writing in accordance with the terms of this section, both herein and hereinafter described, and such approvals shall be published by addendum to notify all Bidders of the items to be accepted as equal to the items specified. No verbal commitment will constitute approval. The Owner's approval shall be only in writing and by addendum prior to bid opening.

Compliance with Contract Documents. Strict adherence to the Contract Documents, including the specifications for the item(s) or product(s) originally specified or approved equals thereof described by addendum, will be required by the Owner. The Furniture Vendor will receive no compensation for loss in production or otherwise of the item(s) or product(s) not equal to those specified or approved by the Owner as equals.

K. SUBSTITUTION REQUEST FORM

See **Appendix K. Substitution Request Form** at the end of General Conditions document

L. DRAWINGS AND SPECIFICATIONS

Ownership of Drawings and Specifications. All Drawings and Specifications and other documents furnished by the Interior Designer are instruments of service and shall remain as such. They are not to be used by the Furniture Vendor on any other project and with the exception of one contract set, they are to be returned to the Interior Designer, upon request, following the completion of Work.

Interrelation of Documents. The Contract Documents are complementary, and what is required by one document shall be as binding as if required at all. The intention of the documents is to describe, in the necessary detail, the Work required for the proper execution and completion of the Contract.

- 1) The drawings, sketches and layouts establish dimensions, quantity, and location of furniture and furnishings within a given space.

2) The specifications determine the nature, the construction details, basic materials, colors, finishes and component parts, as well as the quality of the items.

Resolution of Conflicts in Documents. In the event of conflict between or among the Drawings and Specifications, the better quality shall prevail.

Furniture Vendor's Duty to Review Contract Documents. In order to facilitate its responsibilities for completion of the Work in accordance with and as reasonably inferable from the Contract Documents, prior to commencing the Work, the Furniture Vendor shall examine and compare the Contract Documents, relevant field measures made by the Furniture Vendor and any visible conditions at the Site affecting the Work.

Discrepancies and Omissions in Drawings and Specifications.

1). If the Furniture Vendor discovers any errors, omissions or inconsistencies in the Contract Documents, the Furniture Vendor shall promptly report them to the Owner and the Interior Designer.

2). In the case of system type furniture where components listed are incomplete or incorrect or are incompatible with the intended function, the Furniture Vendor shall notify the Owner prior the placement of an order with the manufacturer.

3). The Furniture Vendor is not liable for errors, omissions, or inconsistencies described in the Contract Documents unless the Furniture Vendor knowingly fails to report a recognized problem to the Owner. The Furniture Vendor is liable for additional costs or damages that could have been avoided by reasonable examination of the Contract Documents or the Project Site.

M. OWNER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

Progress and Pre-Installation Meetings. The Owner may schedule and administer pre-installation meetings, periodic progress meetings and specially called meetings throughout the progress of the Work. Representatives of the Owner, Interior Designer, Contractor, subcontractors and suppliers shall attend the meetings and be qualified and authorized to act on behalf of the entity each represents.

Limitation on Owner's Duties. The Owner will not supervise, direct, control, or have any authority over or be responsible for Contractor's means, methods, technologies, sequences or procedures of construction or installation or the safety precautions and programs thereto. Owner is not responsible for any failure of Contractor to comply with laws and regulations applicable to furnishing or performing the Work. Owner is not responsible for the failure of Furniture Vendor to perform or furnish the work in accordance with the Contract Documents. Owner is not responsible for the

acts or omissions of Furniture Vendor or any subcontractor, supplier or any other person or organization performing or furnishing any of the Work.

N. INTERIOR DESIGNER RESPONSIBILITIES

In General. Unless otherwise provided for the Contract Documents, the Interior Designer will perform the duties of the Interior Designer as described in this Contract during construction and installation and until final payment, including advising the Owner on matters where assistance is needed. The assignment of any authority, duties or responsibilities to the Interior Designer under the Contract Documents, or under any agreement between Owner and Interior Designer, or any performance thereof by Interior Designer is for the exclusive benefit of the Owner and not for the benefit of the Furniture Vendor.

The Interior Designer has the authority to act on behalf of the Owner to the extent provided in the Contract Documents, unless noted otherwise in written form furnished to the Furniture Vendor. The Interior Designer will advise and consult the Owner and the Owner's instruction to the Furniture Vendor will generally be issued through the Interior Designer, except that the Owner reserves the right on occasions, as deemed appropriate by the Owner, to issue instructions directly to the Furniture Vendor.

All written communications between and among the Owner, Furniture Vendor and Interior Designer concerned with the Work shall be furnished to the Owner, the Interior Designer, and the Furniture Vendor by the party originating the communication.

All instructions affecting the Contract Sum, Contract Time or contract interpretation, shall be confirmed expeditiously in writing with copies furnished to the Interior Designer, the Owner and the Furniture Vendor by the party issuing the instruction. No instruction affecting the Interior Designer's design liability shall be issued without the Interior Designer's prior written consent.

The Owner and Interior Designer with the Owner's consent shall interpret Contract requirements and have the authority to reject work performed by the Furniture Vendor which, in the opinion of the Owner or the Interior Designer, does not meet the requirements of the Contract Documents. The Interior Designer shall inform the Owner of any non-compliant Work and the Owner shall determine whether such work should be removed and replaced.

Visits of Site. The Interior Designer will make visits to the Site at intervals appropriate to the various stages of installation as Interior Designer deems necessary or as provided in the Interior Designer's contract with the Owner. The Interior Designer will not be required to make exhaustive or continuous on-site inspections to check the quality or quantity of the Work, unless otherwise provided. The Interior Designer will keep the Owner informed of the progress of the Work and will endeavor to guard Owner against defective Work.

Clarifications and Interpretations. The Interior Designer may determine that written clarifications or interpretations of the requirements of the Contract Documents are necessary. Such written clarifications or interpretations will be consistent with the intent of and reasonably inferable from the Contract Documents, will be issued with reasonable promptness.

Limitations on Interior Designer Authority. Interior Designer will not supervise, direct, control or have authority over or be responsible for Furniture Vendor means, methods, techniques, sequences or procedures of installation, or the safety precautions and programs. The Interior Designer is not responsible for any failure of the Furniture Vendor to comply with laws and regulations applicable to the furnishings or performing of the Work. The Interior Designer is not responsible for Furniture Vendor's failure to perform or furnish the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents. The Interior Designer is not responsible for the acts or omissions of the Furniture Vendor, subcontractor, supplier or any other person or organization furnishing the Work.

O. FURNITURE VENDOR RESPONSIBILITIES

The Furniture Vendor shall supervise and direct the Work using the best skill and attention to assure that each element of the work conforms to the contract requirement. The Furniture Vendor shall be solely responsible for all construction means, methods, techniques, safety, sequences and procedures, and for coordinating Work complies accurately with the Contract Documents.

Knowledge of General and Local Conditions. The Furniture Vendor is responsible for evaluating the premises and conditions under which the Work will be performed. The Furniture Vendor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or extensions of time for any conditions of the premises that could have been discovered by reasonable inspection or reasonably anticipated.

Work Hours. All delivery and installation activities are to be performed during normal working hours, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Access to the Project outside of normal hours requires advance written authorization from the Owner.

Furniture Vendor's Installation Manager. The Furniture Vendor shall employ a competent Installation Manager who shall be present at the Project Site during installation of the Work. The installation manager shall be satisfactory to the Owner and shall not be changed except with the written approval of the Owner, which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld. The installation manager shall represent the Furniture Vendor at the Site and shall have full authority to act on behalf of the Furniture Vendor. All communication given to the installation manager shall be binding on the Furniture Vendor. All oral communications affecting Contract Time, Contract Sum and contract interpretation will be confirmed in writing to the Owner.

Labor. Furniture Vendor shall provide competent, suitably qualified personnel to survey, lay out, and install the Work as required by the Contract Documents. Furniture Vendor shall at all times maintain good discipline and order at the Site.

Services, Materials and Equipment. Unless otherwise specified in the Contract Documents, Furniture Vendor shall provide and assume full responsibility for all services, materials, equipment, labor, transportation, tools and all other incidentals necessary for the performance, installation, and completion of the Work. The Furniture Vendor shall provide, without extra charge, all incidental items required as part of the Work, even though not particularly specified or indicated in the Contract.

No Substitutions Without Approval. The Furniture Vendor may make substitutions only with the consent of the Owner, after evaluation and recommendation by the Interior Designer and in accordance with a Supplemental Purchase Order. If the Furniture Vendor has good reason for objecting to the use of a material, appliance, or method of construction as shown or specified, it shall register its objections with the Interior Designer in writing, sending a copy to the Owner, otherwise it shall proceed with the work with the understanding that a satisfactory job is required.

Should Work be identified by either the Interior Designer and/or Owner as not being in compliance with the Contract Documents, the Owner shall communicate the finding to the Furniture Vendor and such Work shall be corrected by the Furniture Vendor at his/her expense. The approval of Work by either the Interior Designer or Owner does not relieve the Furniture Vendor from compliance with all requirements of the Contract Documents where such requirements are not judged at the time of observation of the Work due to work sequences by the Furniture Vendor or the lack of time to judge the performance characteristics of the particular Work item.

Keying Requirements. Where required, and unless otherwise specified, all locks are to be randomly keyed by work space with all locks for items from a single supplier located in a distinct work space to be keyed alike.

Receipt of Shipments by Contractor. The Furniture Vendor or its representative must be present at the Project site to receive all shipments. Under no circumstances will the Owner or other contractors be responsible for any deliveries made under the Contract. The Furniture Vendor shall provide the exact address of the Project to the manufacturer and/or common carrier.

Delivery and Installation Requirements. Furniture Vendor shall:

Coordinate delivery date for each product in accordance with the installation period. All crates delivered to the site shall be clearly marked with Furniture Vendor's name, the number of pieces in each crate, and the item number for each piece.

Receive and unload products and store as required. The Furniture Vendor shall be responsible for arranging suitable storage for all deliveries which arrive prior to

the installation period. The Furniture Vendor is responsible for storage costs, re-handling, delivery charges or other expenses associated with early delivery.

Promptly inspect products, record shortages, damages, or defective items. Replace defective items and handle shipping claims as required.

Protect all products from exposure to elements and damage.

Uncrate, assemble, install, connect, adjust and make products ready for use in the room or space indicated.

Repair, refinish, and make good any damage to the building resulting from any of its operations. This shall include any damage to wall finish, ceilings, floors or any other finished surfaces.

All minor adjustments, and similar final corrections shall be executed by the Furniture Vendor as directed by the Owner as part of the Work under the Contract.

Cleaning. The Furniture Vendor shall at all times keep the Project Site and the installation areas free from the accumulation of water, waste materials or rubbish during the performance of the Work. Any and all empty cartons, crates, waste materials, rubbish and trash must be removed daily. The Furniture Vendor shall dispose of all waste materials off the property of the Owner. Prior to the Furniture Vendor's requested date for a pre-final inspection, the Furniture Vendor shall remove any and all remaining equipment from the site and shall leave the premises in a clean, neat and workmanlike condition satisfactory to the Owner.

All Furniture Vendor operations, including storage of materials and employee parking upon the site of work, shall be confined to areas designated by the Owner.

The Owner may restrict the Furniture Vendor's entry to the site to specifically assigned entrances and routes.

P. CHANGES IN THE WORK

The Owner, without validating the Contract, may issue a supplemental purchase order that makes the changes in the scope of Work, the Contract Price or the Contract Time. All supplemental purchase orders must be in writing on a form approved by the Owner. The Furniture Vendor is not entitled to any additional compensation for any additional Work performed without a written supplemental purchase order.

At the Owner's request, the Furniture Vendor shall prepare a detailed breakdown of the cost for any requested changes, identifying separately any credit to the Owner for deleted Work and the costs for material, labor, transportation, overhead, and profit for any additional Work. If the parties cannot agree on the terms of a supplemental purchase order, the Owner may issue a supplemental purchase order unilaterally, in accordance with the Contract Documents.

All Work performed under a supplemental purchase order shall comply with the terms and conditions of the original Contract Documents.

No claim for extra compensation for supplemental purchase order Work will be considered by the Owner unless the Furniture Vendor provides written notice to the Owner of its claims before starting the additional Work.

Q. SHOP DRAWINGS AND SUBMITTALS

The Furniture Vendor shall submit, with reasonable promptness and in orderly sequence, all Shop Drawings, Samples or other information required by the Contract Documents. The Furniture Vendor shall review each submittal for compliance with Contract Documents and shall certify that it has done so by stamp or otherwise, affixed to each copy. Submittal data presented without the Furniture Vendor's certification will be returned without review or other comment, and any resulting delay will be the Furniture Vendor's responsibility.

Sustainability Furniture Vendor shall submit paperwork related to the use of sustainable practices performed by furniture manufacturer as well as their contribution to the environment. Any criteria established by the furniture manufacturer shall include and may not be limited to any post-consumer and/or pre-consumer literature the furniture manufacturer provides. These documents shall be part of the submittal package to be reviewed.

Shop Drawings, Samples or other required information shall be of sufficient size to properly represent the Work and identified as required by the Owner and/or Interior Designer. At the time of submission, the Furniture Vendor shall inform the Owner and the Interior Designer in writing of any deviation in the Shop Drawings or Samples from the requirements of the Contract Documents.

By submitting Shop Drawings, Samples and other required information, the Furniture Vendor represents that it has determined and verified all field measurements, field construction criteria, materials, catalog numbers and similar data, or will do so, that it has checked and coordinated each Shop Drawing and Sample with the requirements of the Work and the Contract Documents.

The Interior Designer and the Owner will review and take appropriate action on all submittals with reasonable promptness but only for general conformance with the design concept of the Project and with the information given in the Contract Documents. Approvals will be in writing. The approval of a separate item shall not indicate approval of an assembly in which the item is a part. The approval of the Shop Drawings, or Samples shall not relieve the Furniture Vendor of responsibility for any deviation from the requirements of the Contract Documents unless the Furniture Vendor has informed the Owner or Interior Designer in writing of such deviation at the time of submission and the Owner or the Interior Designer has not objected to the specified deviation. The approval shall not relieve the Furniture Vendor from responsibility for errors or omissions in the Shop Drawings or Samples.

The Furniture Vendor shall make any corrections required to a submittal and shall resubmit the required number of corrected copies of the submittals promptly to avoid delays until approved. The Furniture Vendor shall direct attention in writing to the Interior Designer and the Owner when required, to any new revisions other than the corrections requested on previous submissions.

No Work requiring a Shop Drawing or Sample submission shall be commenced until the submissions have been approved. All such work shall be in accordance with the approved Shop Drawings and Samples.

R. CLOSING INSPECTIONS

Substantial Completion Inspection. When the Furniture Vendor considers the entire Work or designated part thereof substantially complete, the Furniture Vendor shall notify the Owner and the Interior Designer in writing that the Work will be ready for Substantial Completion Inspection on a date certain. The Furniture Vendor shall include with this notice a list of items to be completed or corrected prior to final inspection.

On the date indicated by the Furniture Vendor or as soon thereafter as is practicable, the Owner, the Interior Designer and the Furniture Vendor shall inspect the Work and if the Owner and the Interior Designer determine that the Work is substantially complete a notice of Substantial Completion shall be issued by the Owner fixing the date of Substantial Completion. The Interior Designer will provide with this certificate a list of items to be completed prior to final inspection (Pre Final Punchlist). The Pre-Final Punchlist may include additional items not included in the Furniture Vendor's list, which are deemed necessary by the Interior Designer or by the Owner to correct or complete prior to Final Inspection.

Final Inspection. The Furniture Vendor shall complete the items listed on the Pre-Final Punchlist prior to Final Inspection. The Furniture Vendor shall complete this work within 30 days of the date of Substantial Completion. Upon completion of the Pre-Final Punchlist, Furniture Vendor shall give written notice to the Owner and Interior Designer that the Work will be ready for Final Inspection on a date certain. On this date, or as soon thereafter and is practicable, the Owner, Interior Designer and Furniture Vendor shall inspect the Work and the Interior Designer shall submit to the Furniture Vendor a list of items which the Owner and the Interior Designer have determined to require correction or completion before the Work will be accepted by the Owner (Final Punchlist).

The Furniture Vendor shall correct or complete all items on the Final Punchlist before Acceptance and Final Payment. Unless otherwise specified in the Special Condition, or otherwise agreed in writing by the parties, the Furniture Vendor shall complete this work within 7 days of receiving the Final Punchlist. Upon completion of the Final Punchlist, the Furniture Vendor shall notify the Interior Designer and Owner in writing stating the disposition of each Final Punchlist item and the Interior Designer and Owner shall promptly inspect the completed items. When the Final Punchlist has

been completed, the Contract is fully performed according to the Contract Documents. Final Completion of all Work shall be a condition precedent to the Furniture Vendor's right to receive Final Payment.

S. EARLY OCCUPANCY

Right of Occupancy. The Owner may occupy or use all or any portion of the Work following Substantial Completion or at any earlier stage of completion, provided that such occupancy or use is consented to by any and all insurers of the Work. Should the Owner wish to use or occupy the Work or any designated portion of the Work prior to final completion, the Owner shall notify the Furniture Vendor in writing. Work performed on the premises by third parties on the Owner's behalf does not constitute occupation or use of the Work by the Owner.

Occupancy of Work Prior to Substantial Completion. If the Owner wants to occupy all or a portion of the Work prior to Substantial Completion, it shall inform the Interior Designer and the Furniture Vendor at least 30 days before the date the Owner wishes to occupy the Work and designate the portions of the Work to be occupied. The Owner or Interior Designer shall prepare and submit to the Contractor and Early Occupancy Proposal, specifying any Work that must be completed or corrected as well as any operation and maintenance manuals or other documentation necessary for the Work to be occupied and used by the Owner. The Early Occupancy Proposal shall set out the division of responsibilities between the Owner and the Furniture Vendor for utilities, security, maintenance, insurance and liability for damage to the Work or damage arising from the condition of the Work. The Early Occupancy Proposal shall also specify whether the area to be occupied must be Substantially Complete before occupation and shall specify the date for Substantial Completion of the Work to be occupied if other than the date previously specified by the Contract Documents.

Nonwaiver of Timely Completion. Early occupancy of any portion of the Work does not waive the Furniture Vendor's duty to complete the remaining Work within the Contract Time as specified by the Contract Documents or as modified by the Supplemental Purchase Order.






ENLARGED - LEVEL 1 FURNITURE PLAN (SOUTH)
