This addendum is incorporating the following changes, questions, and answers to the above-referenced RFP.

Section 0500 Scope of Work

- 1.0 (Q) Item 4.11.3.4 – How much site specific training does ACCD required and is it billable?
 (A) This is specific to the Parking Division. The training required for a new guard would be familiarization with the facility in terms of access points, frequent possible occurrences and the associated expectations. Typically, this consists of a short facility tour and discussion which takes approximately 30 minute. - one hour at the beginning of a shift for the new guard. This should not be billable as a separate line item.
- 2.0 (Q) Item 5.3.8 –Based on past history, what is the maximum number of additional guards requested with short notice?
 (A) ACCD requirements are event-driven. Past history has not required ACCD to utilize guards on short notice. However, should a significant event (inclement weather) or other unforeseen/unscheduled event occur which requires calling in Security Guards on short notice, the estimate maximum number needed by the ACCD Security Division is five and the estimate maximum number needed for the Parking Division is two. Due to the nature of ACCD’s business, these numbers are estimates only and subject to change. The remaining City departments information are not currently available as these need are on as needed basis only.
