I. Clarifications:

II. Questions:

- Q) Regarding the RFP for Austin Aviation, my team reviewed the documents, and there are a couple of items that will prevent e-Builder from participating. The following was taken from the RFP: "Although the current system and services are on premise, the Airport is will consider alternate forms of hosting. Cloud solutions must conform to the City's and Airport's Security standards. **Cloud solutions must be single tenant architecture** and must meet all technical requirements stated in the requirements matrix and conform to the City's Cloud Data Services Requirements." We have a multitenant solution, and are also FedRAMP authorized, but we do not have a single tenant solution. This seems to automatically disqualify us.
- A) Without single tenant, City will lose right to audit the system, access security logs and perform security assessment when needed. In additional, City Cloud policy requires other security postures such as advanced network protection, data encryption at rest, data location and ownership, security incident alerts and remediation and so on. Due to the nature of the assets and information to be stored in the system, the Department of Aviation is specifically looking for single tenancy if this is available. If the vendor can show that they will allow Aviation access to audit, etc. then the solution will be considered if it is not a single tenant architecture.
- Q) Secondly, there was an indication that Austin Aviation prefers a local vendor, who has had an office within the Austin city limit for at least the last 5 years. Despite having several remote employees in Austin, we do not have an office there.
- A) This is City of Austin purchasing policy to award points based on local preference.
